Requirements

In order to receive food, you MUST show the following:

- Photo ID of applicant.
- Social Security cards/ birth certificates for all persons in household
- Proof of Gloucester County residency (utility bill, lease or mortgage statement)
- Proof of income (pay stubs, unemployment, Social Security benefits, pension letter, etc.)

No one will receive a food basket without proper documentation.

Women Infant & Children (WIC) Eligibility:

Income guidelines for WIC are the same as for the USDA TEFAP program. Clients may qualify if they are at or below the income guidelines and pregnant (or recently pregnant), a breastfeeding mother (up to 1-year), an infant or child under 5 years old.
